
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


The UPSIDES peer support worker

UPSIDES [1] peer support workers (PSWs) use their own lived experience to guide and help people with severe mental illness on their recovery journey. Thereby, they build a trusting, informal and empathic relationship with their clients on an equal footing [3]. Their knowledge, experience and training enable them to accompany and support other people in crises [2].

UPSIDES peer support is recovery-oriented, based on hope, self-determination, and opportunities. The intervention is guided by nine principles, which are listed in the figure on the right. It was developed to help with the day-to-day challenges that come with mental illness. The support can consist of accompanying clients to authorities, mediating between family and mental health staff, or help with planning their day.



The tree of life

The central principle of UPSIDES peer support is "mutuality", i.e. it involves sharing experiences in a way that is helpful and inspiring to those being supported [4].

One of the tools to share personal stories is the tree of life. This is a useful method to identify strengths and values, and to explore how these are affected by the past. Thus, the tree of life helps to share stories in a recovery-focused way. Starting with the roots and ground, it grows upwards towards the sky - a symbol of hope and future opportunities [4].

During UPSIDES peer support, a client's unique recovery journey is explored based on the tree of life. It consists of different parts, which are presented in the picture on the left. One part is the trunk, which represents your strengths, skills and values. During peer support, the PSW and the client elaborate the client's strengths, skills and values. Possible strengths could be being tolerant, responsible, motivated, and/or diplomatic.

The role of the PSW

Based on the nine principles of peer support, the role of the PSW is to:

- provide an open space for sharing experiences
- show empathy, authenticity and respect
- give and take both sides benefit from the contact
- work out solutions together with their clients
- help their clients grow
- give hope, show possibilities and opportunities
- encourage and support their clients
- promote autonomy
- support to participate in and shape society
- include different perspectives and share knowledge
- facilitate inclusion of different perspectives and equal cooperation between clients, relatives, and health professionals
- maintain one's own boundaries and those of others

- Dissatisfaction at work
